CAMP TOPICS FOR CHILDREN AGES TWO THRU FIFTH GRADE

Session 1 May 29-June 1

Gardening Camp

Session 2 June 4-8

Sports Camp



Do you enjoy learning new sports and games and playing outside? In this sports camp, your elementary student will learn archery, lacrosse, and Quidditch, among other popular individual and team sports. The early childhood age children will work collaboratively to use a parachute, play with various materials such as hula hoops, balls, and ropes, and play different running games. This week is all about having fun while being active and learning good sportsmanship!

Session 3 June 11-15

Book N Cook Camp



We will be cooking our favorite dishes found in our favorite stories during this delicious week of merging literacy and culinary arts. Session 7-July 9-13

Painting Camp



In the cottonwood summer painting camp with Ms. Tricia, we will practice painting techniques of all kinds! We will pair this with basic skills of drawing and form which will help the young artist transform their ideas from their imagination to finished work. Students will discuss and compare many artistic styles and techniques. They will have lessons on watercolor, oil and chalk pastels, acrylic paint and drawing tools. To conclude our camp we will have an art show for the families to come and see the beautiful body of work our young artists have produced.

Session 8-July 16-20

Medieval History Camp

Summer FAQs for the Cottonwood School

- Sibling discounts are not available during the summer sessions.
- Partial payments or partial sessions will not be accepted.
- Each session must be paid in full at time of registration. Refunds will not be issued.
- Summer school enrollment does not guarantee class placement in the fall.
- Children cannot be enrolled without a current immunization record.
- Children should dress in play clothes and comfortable, close-toed walking shoes. **No sandals or flip flops.**
- Children should wear a hat and apply sunscreen liberally before arriving at school each day.
- All children will need a tote bag with a water bottle, a beach towel, a swim suit, sunscreen and an extra set of clothes for water play in each session.
- Personal belongings must be labeled with your child's first and last name.
- Each child will need to bring a fresh, frozen or non-perishable snack and milk or 100% juice for 12, including one dozen cups and napkins, on the first Monday of each session. **No nuts, please!**
- Children enrolled in the 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. session must bring a sack lunch each day.
- Children who extend their program time will be charged an additional childcare fee of \$8 hour.
